My Views on the BBC :-

BBC should remain the British Broadcasting Corporation without influence and infiltration from foreign countries. BBC should provide unbiased and fair reporting, and reports, documentaries, interviews should not have a biased slant.

After traumatic, tragic events the Victims should not be interviewed, or harassed by journalists.

BBC World is an important part of the broadcasting Radio & TV. service.

Governors should have control of the BBC, and be appointed from all members of the public, and not Government appointees, or be accountable to the Government.

The licence fee is probably the most suitable option at present, although income should be generated from commercial ventures, NOT advertising, and sales of programmes to overseas be encouraged. More thought and better programmes for youngsters, do not condescend in broadcasts; the scope for excellent interesting programmes should be great.
