Dear Sir / Madam;

For a long time I have had correspondence with TV licencing people and I sent also; one letter to local MP, who passed my letter to Mrs. TESSA from dept. of media and sport; who is minister. Answers are: general; old fashioned; diplomatic and they do not solve my problem with TV licence.

PROBLEM IS: FACT I: I live on lowest income support £54 a week. FACT II: I have no more money - no savings - no partners or family to help me. FACT III: Both licences: color and black & white are too high to me to pay!!!
I suggested to local MP and TV people that; as far as I am concerned; licence or not is fine; but it should be means testing.
Every person is individual case to be looked upon!

My "famous" solution is this: Person who makes less than 100 pounds a week; should not pay TV licence! That will be only reasonable.

You said: people over 75 should not pay? It is incredible! They have pensions between £75-105£ and + winter fuel money £150. Why should I pay; when I have ONLY £54 for all of my living needs? It is not just stupid but against Human Right! TV people were ~~sending~~ sending me letters every 2 weeks and even man came to my door (I did not allow him in).

I strongly suggest; that people like me become exempt of paying TV licence as soon as possible.

In other way I should be forced to go to the Court of Human Rights in Strasbourg and sue TV licence people and maybe BBC. TV licence people made it all difficult more to me as they could.

I demanded plastic card to pay my licence in installments; but they said: it is only for color tv (I have black & white licence).

Why not paying thru color-plastic card; my black & white licence? Why they make it so difficult. They even mentioned court and £1000 pound fine if I do not pay?

If they do it (ever) I shall sue them all and demand damages 50.00£ for my mental and other frustration. It is case for Carla del Ponte and Criminal Court in Hag (Holland).

I can pay b & w licence £38.50; but only in my time and instalments. I suggest that tv licencing people accep this or I shall sue them and it will be all over European press. Our Prime minister would not like that to happen. Please; send them letter about my case to BRISTOL and explain this!

The name of the woman in charge in Bristol TV licencing is Jacqui THOMPSON (MRS). I have sent her a several letters! I hardly can buy food and live decent life on £54 a week. Nobody cares....

I suggested to local MP that basic income support and JSA should raise from 54 to 75 - or 80 £ a week; so that we all live decent life. Now only pensioners and disabled people have plenty of money!?? That is outrageous and disgraceful.
