What I value most is the news which I trust and have trusted for many years to be as fair as possible in a fallen world. I would like more mention of TEESSIDE in North East News.


I mainly watch films from TV and would like more from the 1940s-1960s. I also like the short educational and wildlife programmes on TV in the early evening.
