Dear BBC,

Thank you for inviting the public to express their opinion of the BBC. The opinion of this party which represents the majority of the English people yet is never once mentioned by John Humphrys or Sarah Montague on Radio 4 or elsewhere on your extensive broadcasts is that the company is corrupt and rigged to spout government propaganda ignoring any genuine opposition which might affect the administration of government or the 'royal charter' granted to it by the occupation forces of Elizabeth Windsor and the Westminster/Whitehall regime.
