Bbc review of bbc royal charter

1. do you think it is helpful to define the bbc's purpose in this way

the bbc role is to promoting education and learning

2 are these the right purposes

the bbc should provide a wide range of content

3 are these the right characteristics

the bbc if they want to play a important role they should not just look at high quality television

4 do you agree that the bbc should be at the forefront of developments in technology, eg digital television

the bbc should help in community radio as well as community television they could use the profits from the bbc to invest in the community that pay the licence fee.

Then after five years if the community radio station closes before its time the bbc takes it over

5 do you support the proposal of a further review of alternative funding methods before the end of the next charter period.
