After all it is their policy which will destroy thousands of TVs etc throughout the UK when it could run hand in hand with the preston system;

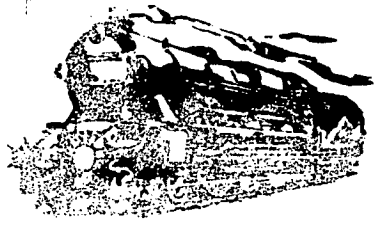
