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Introduction

This document presents a series of detailed tables analysing the headline fuel poverty statistics for 2006. The statistics have been derived from the 2006 combined sample English House Condition Survey (EHCS) dataset. The figures are presented using both the 'Full' and 'Basic' definitions of income (see below). Definitions used to calculate fuel poverty and other variables can be found in the Fuel Poverty Methodology Documentation. Categories have been grouped where necessary to ensure that figures quoted are based on large enough samples but caution should be exercised when conducting further analysis to ensure that sample sizes are robust¹. The Building Research Establishment (BRE) is able to provide further clarification and can be contacted through fuelpoverty@bre.co.uk .

Two definitions of income are used in relation to fuel poverty; 'Basic' income and 'Full' income. The fuel poverty basic income measure is the household income, including the Winter Fuel Payment (made payable only to those eligible). Basic income excludes income related directly to housing. The Fuel Poverty Full income variable is created by adding the income related to housing costs; i.e. housing benefit, ISMI, MPPI and council tax benefit to the Basic income variable, and by subtracting the council tax payable. The Full income definition is used for targeting. For both definitions it is the income, net of income tax and national insurance, of the whole household. That is the income of the Household Reference Person (HRP) and any partner, plus any other adult member.
