HMG's 'Transformational Government Enabled by Technology' was read with great interest by Telsecure's technology professionals. We wish to make the following comments.

At para 19, the document states "Technologies have emerged into widespread use – for instance the mobile phone and other mobile technologies – which government services have yet to properly exploit."

Telsecure have proven technology for minimising card not present fraud; this is currently running at £150 million per annum in the UK. This substantial weakness in the financial transactions sector has yet to be challenged by the Industry itself and we at Telsecure recognise the duty of Government to be as proactive as possible in challenging established industry practice such that these forms of weakness are overcome.

The document has laudable aims and we believe the document should include in its next update HMG's listings of practical realisable solutions to current overtly stated weaknesses. We believe that Telsecure's securePay and secureCard should feature because they are proven technologies that overcome card not present fraud.

We respectfully suggest that the document provide facility to include suggestions of technologies now available but not yet in widespread use, so that HMG may be seen by relevant Industry sectors to be aware of and encouraging evaluation for potential gain.

Telsecure would welcome an opportunity to present our solutions to HMG given the outstanding need to combat card not present fraud.
