4. Interpreting changes in OASys scores should be done with caution. For example, some OASys score changes may reflect more information having become available, rather than any real differences in the offenders' circumstances.
5. At present the rate of completion of termination reviews is low, and completion rates should be considered when attempting to make comparisons over time or between different probation areas or LAs. In order to remedy this, the National Offender Management Service (NOMS) has set as a non-negotiable target a requirement that probation areas complete termination reviews. Initial findings show that this has led to an increase of nearly 40% in the rate of termination reviews; data is more reliable already and if this trend continues will become increasingly more so.
6. Comparisons between different time periods are limited by the comparability of offenders assessed in each time period. This is particularly relevant for areas where the rate of completed termination assessments is improving, where it is probable that terminations were previously completed on a select, untypical group of offenders.
7. Small sample sizes can limit the generalisability of findings, and should be interpreted with a great deal of caution.
