

Please find below a few comments in regards the consultation document.

Q. 21

Pressure needs to be put on breweries to take more responsibility within the injuries that occur around their premises. This could include the type of glass used for drinking out of, bottle bins etc.

Q. 23

There are many gaps in the evidence involving alcohol and crime. These gaps need to be addressed so that partnerships can start with a comprehensive baseline, targeting limited resources effectively.

Q. 52

There is a trend by breweries to sell large amounts of alcohol cheaply, ie 5 bottles for £5. This encourages binge drinking of powerful drinks. Whether any pressure could be placed on breweries to reduce, if not stop this trend.
