Further to our recent email I have now heard from Hertfordshire Travel Unit.

The position appears to be that Arriva provide the present and only bus service in Bramfield. Sovereign do not and it appears will not be involved in Bramfield in the future. Therefore there are no direct implications for the village of Bramfield from the proposed acquisition.

Bramfield Parish Council cannot therefore comment on the details of the acquisition. However the Parish Council is an advocate of rural public transport. Bramfield is served by a very limited service and there is a possibility it will be cut even further. The Parish Council hopes that this who make decisions about the provision of bus services will ensure that rural transport is protected and that company acquisitions and contract awards do not bring about reduction in services which are essential for many members of rural communities.
