Dear Mrs Harvey,

Thank you for your recent letter regarding the Stansted Quinquennial review.

CPT has a good working relationship with BAA Stansted. Recently this has resulted in a joint agreement regarding the introduction of Coach Parking charges at the airport. This has been done through timely negotiations with plenty of notice given to Operators to enable them to prepare for their introduction later this summer. This is in stark contrast to the relationship with BAA Heathrow where increased Coach Parking charges are introduced without consultation and a suitable notice period to Operators.

BAA Stansted through its Bus and Coach Transport partnership regularly meets Operators of the Bus and Coach Station to discuss service enhancements, review existing service performance, Staff Travel Plans and security arrangements. It also regularly assists Operators in producing Public Information designed to encourage more use of public transport when travelling to/from the Airport.
