2. Argus Newspapers' specialist national titles are listed below:

*Jobsearch UK*-a fortnightly paid-for listings title featuring up to 3,000 vacancies per issue classified by region and by job type. *Jobsearch UK* is published from the Slough office of RN and has a current circulation of around 18,000.

*Early Times*-a weekly paid-for newspaper aimed at young people aged between 10 and 16 (the title was bought by Argus from Garth Publications in 1991). It sells through the news trade and by annual subscription, and its current circulation is 12,000. *Early Times* is published from the Streatham office of SLP.

*Independent Hotelier*-a free newspaper for the hotel industry; as with the industry it serves, it has been severely affected by the recession. Its current distribution is 6,000 copies. *Independent Hotelier* is published from the Slough office of RN.

*Independent Schools*-a facility management monthly free newspaper for the independent education sector, mailed directly to bursars and head teachers. Its current monthly distribution is 2,000 copies. *Independent Schools* is published from the Kingston office of LNSN.
