## Conditions attached to fare categories

### Fare description-NEL

SS = Standard Single:	Valid where travel is on any Friday throughout the year, Saturday 25 May, all Saturdays in July and August and other Standard fare days as notified to sales agents.
ES = Economy Single:	Valid where travel is on any day except Friday throughout the year, Saturday 25 May, all Saturdays in July and August and other Standard fare days as notified to sales agents.
SR = Standard Return:	Valid where travel in either direction is on any Friday throughout the year, Saturday 25 May, all Saturdays in July and August and other Standard fare days as notified to sales agents. Return journey must be made within three months of the outward journey or before the seasonal cessation of the service, whichever is earlier.
SAR = Standard Advance Return:	Valid where travel is on any Friday throughout the year, Saturday 25 May, all Saturdays in July and August and other Standard fare days as notified to sales agents. Advance fares are subject to availability and may not be available on certain days. Tickets must be booked at least seven days in advance of travel, open-dated returns are not allowed, and special refund rules apply. Return journey must be made within three months of the outward journey or before the seasonal cessation of the service, whichever is earlier. No further discounts for children and Coachcard holders.
ER = Economy Return:	Valid where travel in either direction is on any day except Friday throughout the year, Saturday 25 May, all Saturdays in July and August and other Standard fare days as notified to sales agents. Return journey must be made within three months of the outward journey or before the seasonal cessation of the service, whichever is earlier.
EAR = Economy Advance Return:	Valid where travel is on any day except Friday throughout the year, Saturday 25 May, all Saturdays in July and August and other Standard fare days as notified to sales agents. Advance fares are subject to availability and may not be available on certain days. Tickets must be booked at least seven days in advance of travel, open-dated returns are not allowed and special refund rules apply. Return journey must be made within three months of the outward journey or before the seasonal cessation of the service, whichever is earlier. No further discounts for children and Coachcard holders.

### Validity of fares-MML

#### *SVR (Saver Return)*

From St Pancras, outward journey Mondays to Fridays by any train before 0230, between 0929 to 1615 and from 1859. Also valid on 1830 to Langley Mill and Alfreton. Outward journey by any train other dates. Return journey on any train.

To St Pancras, valid outward journey Mondays to Fridays on trains below and all later trains (by any train other days). Return journey on any train.

### ***SSR (SuperSaver Return)***

From St Pancras, outward journeys Mondays to Thursdays by any train before 0230, between 0929 to 1559 and from 1859 and by any train other 'off-peak' days. Also valid on 1830 to Langley Mill and Alfreton. Not valid on return from any station on the following: from Derby on 0505, 0600, 0610; from Nottingham on 0533, 0638, 0800; from Sheffield on 0622, 0632, 0720; from Leeds on 0635, 0725. Return journey Mondays to Thursdays (or other 'off-peak' days) any train.

To St Pancras, valid outward journey Mondays to Thursdays on trains below and all later trains (by any train other 'off-peak' days). Return journey Monday to Thursday on any train timed to depart London between 0930 and 1530 and from 1900 (by any train other 'off-peak' days).

### ***SAR (SuperAdvance Return)***

Advance and SuperAdvance Return tickets are available for certain journeys priced at the SuperSaver and Saver rates respectively, depending on time of departure. These tickets may be purchased up to 1400 on day prior to travel, but as with APEX fares, the return journey must be booked at the same time as the outward journey.

### ***AXR (APEX Return)***

APEX Return tickets can be used on any day of the week. Bookings are limited and tickets must be booked at least seven days in advance. They are valid, both outward and return, only on the specified date and train as endorsed on the ticket at time of booking and are not available for break of journey except for continuation by a recognized connecting service when a change of train is necessary.

Bookings are limited and free seat reservations are issued at time of booking. Return travel may be made within one month of the outward journey, but must be booked at the same time as the outward journey.

APEX and SuperAdvance Return tickets are available only by specified services and precise details of available trains should be obtained locally from stations.
