It will directly connect to at least 1000 existing organisations and create a campaign for change reaching many more. The two-year action research programme will create a 'tipping point' for change in the way that not-for-profit arts and cultural organisations do business and how the sector is funded. Isle of Wight Healthcare NHS and Primary Care Trust	A Lifetime's Health Delivered Creatively	This project will use arts programmes to improve health opportunities, focussing on three key health groups: obese and overweight children aged 5-7 years, adults aged 18-65 with mild to moderate mental health needs, and stroke survivors and their carers aged over 55. It will compare the cost-benefits and effectiveness of arts treatments with drugs, sessions with medical practitioners and public health and social services, and develop new models for public service partnerships and health service referrals onto arts programmes.
