Dear Sir,

With reference to the Government's desire to receive responses to its proposals on the ownership of the media in the United Kingdom I make the following assertions.

In view of the Government's wish to encourage competition and economic growth whilst ensuring plurality of voice and diversity of content I believe that they should remove ownership restrictions on religious broadcasters, in order to help stimulate expansion by a British Christian broadcasting industry.

I believe that religious broadcasting organisations should have the legal right, not just at the discretion of the regulator Ofcom to be able to hold the following licences:

National digital (DAB) sound programme service licence.

Local digital (DAB) sound programme service licence.

DAB multiplex (local or national).

DRM radio licence (local, national or international).

Local analogue AM or FM licence (Commercial or Access radio).

Cable or satellite radio licence.

Cable or satellite TV licence.

Local TV licence.
