

Bournemouth

Here is summary of the 10 representations received in relation to Bournemouth Council's casino bid.

Support

- We received 10 letters expressing support for Bournemouth's casino bid.
- All commended Bournemouth as a location, for its combination of leisure and business tourism visitors and the substantial local population of Bournemouth and Poole.¹
- Also highlighted by 8 of the 10 were Bournemouth's good transport links and the need for regeneration.²
- Of these, one letter highlighted that a casino development would bring major economic benefits in the form of employment opportunities for local residents.³
- One letter also remarked that it is their belief that Bournemouth has one of the best market catchments in South coast to sustain a large or small casino.⁴

Opposition

- We received no letters in opposition to Bournemouth Council's casino bid.
