

East Lindsey

Here is summary of the 8 representations received in relation to East Lindsey Council's casino bid.

Support

- We received 7 letters in support of East Lindsey's bid.
- Of these, 5 letters stressed the positive impact a casino would have in terms of the region's visitor economy, which at the moment is largely seasonal.¹
- All seven letters recognised the significant regenerative potential of such a casino and the job opportunities it would offer.²

Objections

- We received one letter expressing a generally anti-gambling sentiment, along with lack of local consultation.³
