

Appendix A: Draft Regulations

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Licensing Act 2003 (Permitted Temporary Activities) (Notices) Regulations 2005 and shall come into force on [].

Interpretation

2.—(1) In these Regulations “the Act” means the Licensing Act 2003.

(2) In these Regulations any reference to a—

- (a) Schedule should be construed as a reference to the Schedule in these Regulations; and
- (b) section should be construed as a reference to a section in the Act.

Temporary event notice

3. A temporary event notice given under section 100 shall be in the form prescribed in Schedule 1 and shall contain the information required under that Schedule.

Acknowledgement of notice

4. The notice returned by a licensing authority under section 102(1) must be marked with an acknowledgement of the receipt in the form of the signature of a person authorised to acknowledge receipt of the temporary event notice on behalf of the licensing authority in the appropriate box in the form prescribed in Schedule 1.

Counter notice

5. A counter notice, given under section 107, shall be

(1) in the form prescribed in Schedule 2 and shall contain the information required under that Schedule; and

(2) given to the premises user by delivering it to him, or by leaving it at the address given by the premises user in the temporary event notice received by the licensing authority or by sending it by post to him at that address.
