Ann Green has been appointed Chairman of the Board of Trustees of the Royal Armouries. The term of appointment will be four years from 28 April 2003.

Ann Green is a trustee of the Royal Armouries and has been Deputy Chairman since November 2001. She is a business consultant and Director for Harkers Engineering Ltd; Adamson Ussher Consultancy; Turnbridge Engineering Company Ltd; Eezycash Ltd; Triangle Multi-media Ltd and J Pickles Healthcare. She is a former Chairman of the British Broadcasting Corporation Advisory Council for the North and member of the English National Forum.

She holds no other public appointments and has not carried out any political activity in the last five years.

Notes to Editors

The Royal Armouries is responsible for the national collection of arms and armour, including part of the historic Royal Collection. The collection is located at HM Tower of London, Fort Nelson and Leeds. The Museum is governed by a Board of Trustees which was established under the National Heritage Act 1983. One member is appointed by the HM the Queen. Other members are appointed by the Secretary of State for Culture Media and Sport. The Constable of the Tower (appointed by the Secretary of State for Defence) is also an ex-officio member by virtue of his office. The Chairman of the Royal Armouries is not remunerated.
