

I am a full-time writer, and PLR gives a significant boost to my income. I think PLR should be extended to cover forms such as audio books and ebooks, as this type of use is bound to increase.

Increases in the PLR rate and 'ceiling' would also be welcome. It is an extremely useful stream of income. The retail life of a book can be short, but as I know to my advantage, PLR can continue to accrue a dozen years after publication.

What I would not like to see is the existing 'pot' of PLR simply stretched to cover the new forms of lending. That would result in those whose books do not appear in the new media getting less than they do now.
