Kate Adie OBE has been re-appointed as a Trustee of the Imperial War Museum The term of appointment will be for four years from 1 April 2003.

#### Biographical Notes

Kate Adie is a distinguished news reporter, with an international reputation for her coverage of areas of conflict and has been the BBC 's Chief News Correspondent since 1989. She was awarded an OBE 1993. Other awards are the RTS News Award and the BAFTA Richard Dimbleby Award. She has not undertaken any significant political activity in the past five years.

#### Notes to Editors

The Imperial War Museum was founded in 1917 to "record the story of the Great War" and was set up under the Imperial War Museum Acts of 1920 and 1925. Its remit was later extended to cover the Second World War and further expanded to all military operations involving British or Commonwealth forces since August 1914.
