Robert Morton has been appointed a Trustee of the Royal Armouries. The term of the appointment will be for four years from 22 January 2003

### **Biographical details**

Robert Morton is a Chartered Accountant and Fellow of the Institute of Chartered Accountants in England and Wales and Head of RDM Associates, a financial and business consultancy. Prior to setting up RDM Associates, Mr Morton held Finance Directorships which include Ashleigh Holdings between 1990 and 1997.

He holds no other public appointments and has not carried out any political activity in the last five years.

### **Note for Editors**

The Royal Armouries is responsible for the national collection of arms and armour, including part of the historic Royal Collection. The collection is located at HM Tower of London, Fort Nelson and Leeds. The Museum is governed by a Board of Trustees which was established under the National Heritage Act 1983. One member is appointed by the HM the Queen. Other members are appointed by the Secretary of State for Culture Media and Sport. The Constable of the Tower (appointed by the Secretary of State for Defence) is also an ex-officio member by virtue of his office.
