

## **HORNIMAN PUBLIC MUSEUM AND PUBLIC PARK TRUST**

The Secretary of State has appointed Timothy Hornsby as Chairman Designate of the Horniman Museum, to become Chairman on 1 April 2004.

### **Biographical note**

Timothy Hornsby was the Chief Executive of the National Lottery Charities Board and is currently a Commissioner for the National Lottery Commission (2001) and a Trustee of the Charles Darwin Trust. He was previously Chief Executive of the Royal Borough of Kingston upon Thames (1991-1995) and Director of the Construction Directorate in the Department of Environment (1991), Director General of the Nature Conservancy Council (1988-91), Director of Ancient Monuments Historic Buildings and Rural affairs at the Department of Environment 1983-88. He worked at Her Majesties Treasury (1971-73) and held numerous Non-Executive Directorships. He has written various book reviews and articles for Journals. His academic experience includes Research Lecturer and Tutor for Christ Church, Oxford University (1964-65). He has appeared frequently on BBC's 'To-day' programme. Timothy has had no significant political activity in the last five years.

### **Notes to Editors**
