NATIONAL MUSEUMS LIVERPOOL

The Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport has appointed Brian Wong as a Trustee of National Museums Liverpool. The four-year appointment began on 19 April 2004.

Biographical Details

Brian Wong has been Managing Director of Fo Ho Finance Investment Co Ltd since 1997 and is Economic Adviser for Kaiping City and Jiangmen City Overseas Investment Bureaus in China. He was founder, then Chief Executive, of Liverpool Chinatown Business Association Liverpool (1989-), founder of Chinese North West Council (2001) and Association Manager of the Liverpool Chamber of Commerce & Industry (1998-). He has been a Board Member of Granby Toxteth Development Trust and an Advisory Council Member of BBC Television North West. He has been a Justice of Peace since 1994 and became Deputy Lieutenant of Merseyside in 2002.

He has undertaken no significant political activity in the last five years.

National Museums Liverpool (formerly National Museums and Galleries on Merseyside) comprises seven museums and galleries and a Conservation Centre. The museums and galleries include the Liverpool Museum, Museum of Liverpool Life, Walker Art Gallery, Lady Lever Art Gallery, Sudley House, Merseyside Maritime Museum and HM Customs and Excise National Museum.

The Board of Trustees are appointed by the Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport. The current Chair is Mr David McDonnell and the Director is Dr David Fleming OBE.

The Trustee posts are not remunerated.

All appointments are made on merit and political activity plays no part in the selection process.
