

This table summarises the principal categories and maximum number of gaming machines that can be provided by different types of premises. Only Category B1 to D gaming machines are shown since there are no Category A machines (legally permitted only in a regional casino). Category B3A gaming machines are only available in non-commercial clubs.

Casinos	Existing casinos may offer up to 20 Category B1-4 machines or opt instead for an unlimited number of C and D machines. The eight large casinos permitted under the new Gambling Act may offer up to 150 Category B1 machines, and the eight small casinos up to 80 Category B1 machines.
