COMMENTS ON THE REVISED GUIDELINES MADE UNDER SECTION 182
OF THE LICENSING ACT 2003

I refer to the consultation document and would make the following comments:-
We generally welcome the remarks made in the revised guidelines, and note below the places with which we disagree or wish to make further comments regarding any particular question.

QUESTION 3

We agree with the remarks but would also ask for better guidance on how the 'primary activity' in any establishment is defined.

QUESTION 7

We support Option 2

QUESTION 13

We agree with the Government's proposals, but would wish that they went further, viz. better guidance on the number of establishments for which any individual should reasonably be a Designated Premises Supervisor, and also (but perhaps a change to the Act would be necessary for this), that there should be a requirement for a person who holds a personal licence to be present on every occasion alcohol is sold.

QUESTION 29

We agree with this, but would suggest also that there should be some means of adding cross-referencing information... within the document wherever relevant.

QUESTION 31

We would have liked to have had better guidance on Temporary/Occasional Events. However, this might also require a revision of the legislation itself but any information within the guidelines a first step and acceptable.

I trust that these remarks will receive due consideration and will contribute to the national consultation on the guidelines.
