Hunger and food security         | <p>Supporting initiatives that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• help food markets work better for the poor, e.g. welcome COMESA's 'maize without borders'</li> <li>• provide cheaper, more accessible food</li> <li>• take preventative action against hunger, e.g. famine early warning systems that help countries to plan better responses</li> </ul> <p>Supporting social transfers that:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• provide a regular, predictable safety net rather than emergency relief</li> <li>• raise consumption and build demand for agricultural goods and services, and create incentives to deepen markets</li> <li>• enhance the possibility of risk taking among poorer farmers</li> </ul> |

Research, science and technology | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Under Sustainable Agriculture Research Strategy developing 3 five year regional research programmes to meet regional needs and build regional agricultural change capacities</li> <li>• Supporting institutions like the African Agricultural Technology Foundation</li> </ul>   |
