

Errata Table

Since the publication of the 2004 edition of *Statistics on International Development (SID)*, we have discovered that some of the expenditure on Technical Co-operation personnel (see Table 12) was miscoded. We have reviewed the information on our database, and have prepared the table below which sets out revised headline figures. All tables will be fully revised in the next edition of *SID*, due in October 2005.

Note that the tables in SID on-line do not show these amendments but the incorrect figures have been highlighted. The tables that are mainly affected are 3,7,9,11.1, 12 and 13. In such cases please refer to the errata table below for revised totals.
