

The Future Development of Air Transport in the UK: Scotland

EDINBURGH AIRPORT EXHIBITION

A Government consultation is underway to examine how air services and airports should develop over the next 30 years. This includes options for expanding Edinburgh Airport.

As part of the consultation process you are invited to visit the Edinburgh Airport Exhibition.

You will be able to view maps of the options and presentations summarising the appraisal of those options, pick up relevant documentation and find out how you can take part in the consultation. Department for Transport, Scottish Executive and Scotland Office staff and their consultants will be present to provide advice and answer questions.

The exhibition will be open from 8.00 a.m. – 8.00 p.m. on 9th October at the Edinburgh Hilton, Edinburgh International Airport, Edinburgh EH28 8LL

There is free parking at the hotel and disabled parking is available. By road the hotel is situated within the airport boundaries. The hotel is clearly signposted on the road, which exits the airport. By air, The hotel is situated 0.2 km from the airport. To call the Hilton courtesy bus, simply use the telephone situated within the terminal building. Alternatively, the Hilton is a ten-minute walk from the airport: follow the exit road round and the Hilton is situated on the left.
