LINX is a mutual organisation owned by more than 120 Internet service providers (ISPs) and content delivery service providers (CDSPs). It owns and operates high-capacity switching and routing equipment that connects the networks of its members, allowing Internet traffic to move efficiently around the world. Most of the UK's major ISPs are LINX members and the organisation handles up to 96 per cent of UK Internet traffic.
