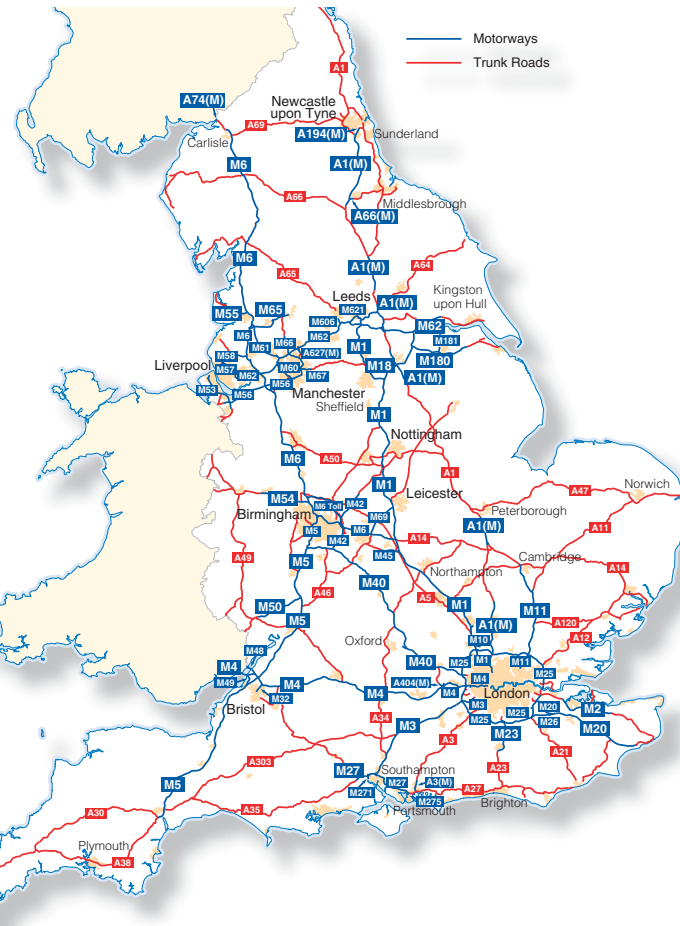


## National Traffic Control Centre Road Network

The NTCC Road Network is the majority of England's motorways and major A-roads currently operated and maintained by the Highways Agency. Today, there are over thirty four million drivers in England, and even though the NTCC's 6500 km Road Network only covers about two percent of the roads available, it carries one third of all traffic and two thirds of freight, making these roads the backbone of the English network.

### Safe driving at roadworks



During 2006 two workers were killed and 19 seriously injured in the course of their work on Highways Agency roads.

For the safety of all road users and roadworkers, when you are approaching roadworks:

- Keep within the speed limit – it is there for your safety.
- Get into the correct lane in good time – don't keep switching.
- Concentrate on the road ahead, not the roadworks.
- Be alert for works' traffic leaving or entering roadworks.
- Keep a safe distance – there could be queues in front.
- Observe all signs – they are there to help you.

**Remember that tiredness can kill. Take regular breaks from driving.**
