## **REGULATORY INSPECTION AND ENFORCEMENT REVIEW**

I am writing to ask for your opinion on how the inspection and enforcement of regulations affects your business.

Gordon Brown has asked me to lead a review examining the scope for promoting more efficient approaches to regulatory inspection and enforcement. As part of that work, I am keen to hear what businesses think about the way inspection and enforcement regimes operate and to listen to suggestions for any beneficial changes that could be made.
