Introduction

The principal activity of the Department is to ensure the security and defence of the United Kingdom and the Overseas Territories, including against terrorism, and to support the Government's foreign policy objectives, particularly in promoting international peace and security. The diversity of MOD's commitments is reflected in its size as one of the largest government departments and in the huge number, variety and complexity of its assets. Its responsibilities range from research into new technologies through equipment procurement to full scale military operations with concomitant training and logistic support facilities; its locations number several thousand and are spread throughout the world.

The Department's input into the previous published version of the National Asset Register in November 1997 was acknowledged as a snapshot of the information available at that time when Resource Accounting was being developed but had not been implemented. On the 31 January 2001 the Department laid before Parliament its first set of audited Resource Accounts. These accounts are now in the public domain and are available from The Stationery Office.

Stewardship and the efficient management of the Departments assets are the responsibility of Top Level Budget (TLBs) Holders. The principal source of information is from the TLB's Fixed Assets Registers and the values attached can be reconciled back to the published accounts for the Financial Year ended 31 March 2000.

Since the publication of the 1997 National Asset Register the department has reorganised its internal TLB structure. The Defence Logistics Organisation was formed as a result of the Strategic Defence Review and consists of the former Naval Support Command, the Quartermaster General and RAF Logistics Command. The Vice Chief of Defence Staff and 2nd Permanent Under Secretary of State TLBs have merged to become the Central TLB; with the separation of Chief of Joint Operations to form a new TLB. A number of changes have also taken place in respect of Agencies.

Although Agency accounts are consolidated into the Departmental Resource Accounts, apart from those Agencies established as Trading Funds, they are subject to separate audit and the Agencies lay their own accounts before Parliament. Agency assets are shown separately from their parent TLB in this publication. More recent developments within the structure include Military Survey and Joint Air Reconnaissance Intelligence Centre Agencies combining to become the Defence Geographic Imagery Intelligence Agency, along with the Army Technical Support Agency ceasing to exist and being absorbed into the Defence Logistics Organisation from 1 April 2000; and the Defence Clothing and Textiles Agency ceasing to exist and being absorbed into the Defence Logistics Organisation from 1 October, 2000.

The register also covers assets held by the three Trading Funds and the seven Executive Non Departmental Public Bodies (NDPBs) for which the Department is responsible. These bodies produce accounts with summary asset values. The Department accounts for public dividend capital in respect of the Trading Funds. The Department also sponsors seven Executive NDPBs to carry out prescribed functions within Government guidelines. They operate at arms length from Ministers within predetermined limits of operational independence.

The submission for the current National Asset Register is in much greater detail than that published in 1997 with the values (as at 31 March 2000) being included for the first time. Also included for the first time are asset category details for Development Costs and Assets in the Course of Construction. However a detailed listing of individual assets would not be practicable for the purposes of this Register due to the volumes of assets held. Assets have therefore been aggregated.

The value of the assets has been ascertained using methodologies consistent with professional valuations with values being on an existing use basis and not market value for disposal. The Defence Estate was valued by a firm of chartered surveyors with the valuation methodology being based on the Depreciated Replacement Cost which is deemed the most appropriate for public sector properties which are rarely sold in the open market for their existing use. These valuations were the subject of a professional peer review.

Overseas estate for which the Crown holds no legal title but which is used for garrison and training purposes by British Forces is included in the MOD's Fixed Asset Registers in accordance with UK Accounting Standards and the Treasury Resource Accounting Manual. UK bases occupied by visiting forces are also included although there is no beneficial use to the MOD.

Defence Investment Strategy

The departmental expenditure on fixed asset additions amounted to £6.1 billion in 1999-00 (£5.6 billion in 1998-99) and cash flow proceeds from fixed asset disposals amounted to £234 million in 1999-00 (£62 million in 1998-99).

Capital investment represents a sizeable proportion of overall Defence spending over the next three years. This will ensure the department is able to deliver the major programme of MODernisation set out in the Strategic Defence Review; invest in the new equipment needed to ensure that our Armed Forces address the main equipment lessons learned from operational experience including the Kosovo campaign; and improve the living and working conditions of our personnel. The Department has a Public Service Agreement target to continue the drive for the optimum utilisation of the Defence asset base, with disposals of over £600 million of assets by March 2004. The Meteorological Office

The Meteorological Office was formed in 1854, as a small department within the Board of Trade, to provide meteorological and sea-current information to mariners. Early last century, the Meteorological Office started responding to new demands for weather services, most importantly in the field of aviation. The RNM has its origins in the Dockyard Museum, founded in 1911, and subsumed within the Victory Museum in 1938, under the auspices of the Society for Nautical Research. In 1972, upon the occasion of the gift of a major collection of Nelson memorabilia to the Royal Navy, the various collections were taken over by the MOD and thus the Royal Naval Museum was established. In 1985, the Museum became an Executive Non-Departmental Public Body, supported by a Grant-in-Aid from MOD.
