Terrorism (United Nations Measures) Order 2006 Al-Qaida and Taliban (United Nations Measures) Order 2006

Her Majesty's Treasury issues this notice to advise that a High Court judgment has today quashed the Terrorism Order (United Nations Measures) Order 2006 and the Al-Qaida and Taliban (United Nations Measures) Order 2006 ('the Orders'). The asset freezing regimes enforced by the Orders give effect to UN asset-freezing obligations in relation to terrorism, Al-Qaida and the Taliban.

On application by the Treasury the Judge granted leave to appeal to the Court of Appeal against the judgment and ordered that the judgment does not come into effect for 21 days to allow the Treasury the opportunity to appeal to the Court of Appeal.

Therefore both Orders remain in force for the time being.
