Section 1 | The Department for Education and Employment

Introduction

The department's overall aim is 'to give everyone the chance, through education, training and work, to realise their full potential and thus build an inclusive and fair society and a competitive economy.' To achieve our aim the department works to:

- **Objective 1** – Ensure that all young people reach 16 with the skills, attitudes and personal qualities that will give them a secure foundation for lifelong learning, work and citizenship in a rapidly changing world;
- **Objective 2** – Develop in everyone a commitment to lifelong learning, so as to enhance their lives, improve employability in a changing labour market and create skills that our economy and employers need;
- **Objective 3** – Help those without a job into work.

The Department for Education and Employment, the Employment Service and OFSTED have responsibility for five Votes in Class I; Votes 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5. Vote 1 is the Core Department's programmes and central services, Vote 2 the Teachers' Superannuation, England and Wales, Vote 3 is the executive agency the Employment Service, Vote 4 is OFSTED and Vote 5 is Sure Start. The Teachers Superannuation Vote 2 is administered by Capita on behalf of the DfEE and is funded in a way that is analogous to the Principle Civil Service Pension Scheme (PCSPS) and as such there are no fixed assets held in connection to this Vote. OFSTED is a non-ministerial government department, created by an Act of Parliament in 1992 and is independent of the DfEE.

These NDPBs are wholly funded from levy income (the department having no call on the assets) but have been included as they are NDPBs of the DfEE.

The assets for the Educational Transfer Council (ETC) have been excluded on the grounds of materiality as the assets they hold are below £100,000.

All DfEE sponsored NDPBs are subject to limitations on the sale of assets acquired with the aid of Government grants. Where assets are sold the sale proceeds or a proportion of them if the grant was less than the whole cost of the acquisition or improvement should be surrendered to the Consolidated Fund as extra receipts. Where an NDPB holds charitable status other restrictions may be imposed on the assets held.

The schedule of assets for DfEE is as at 31 March 2000. The NDPB details are as at the date corresponding to their year end accounts.

The Student Loan Company (SLC), an NDPB of the department, administers the portfolio of student loans. These loans are not assets of the NDPB and are therefore not included as part of their balance sheet, rather, a note to their accounts headed 'Statement of Loans Administered' is included. The loans repayable in more than one year appear as assets on the department's balance sheet, whilst loans repayable in less than one year are classified as debtors in the current asset note.

The SLC is wholly owned by the Government. Its shares are currently owned by the Secretary of State for Education and Employment and the Secretary of State for Scotland. The future of the Scottish shares is under consideration. The SLC administers the student support scheme within the policy context set by the Governments and the legislative framework of the Teaching and Higher Education Act 1998, the Education (Scotland) Act 1980 (as amended), the Education (Student Support) (Northern Ireland) Order 1998, the Education Student Loans Act 1990 (as amended), the Education (Student Loans) (Northern Ireland) Order 1990, as amended, and the associated regulations. The Company pays out loans and grants under the student support scheme, and mortgage style loans to students eligible under the old loans scheme. It makes publicly funded tuition fee payments to HEIs. It recovers loans due for repayment directly (mortgage style loans and income contingent borrowers repaying via the Inland Revenue). The student support scheme is designed to spread the cost of student support more fairly amongst graduates, parents and taxpayers. The Government considers that, with the continued expansion in higher education, students should invest in their future and become more self-reliant.
