Notes

2. Part-time position. Salary for three-day week is pro rata to Group 5 rate.
3. Also known as Social Security and Child Support Appeals Tribunal.
4. All four offices currently held by the same person. Current incumbent (as at 1/4/02) paid at Group 4 rate.
5. Under an arrangement established in April 2002 the current post-holder receives a salary of 108% of the Group 5 rate.
6. Chancery, Mercantile and Patents Judges.
7. Post holders are paid the salary for Group 5 so long as they are required to carry out significantly different work from their counterparts elsewhere in the UK.
8. Current post-holder receives a salary of 110% of Group 7 rate.
9. 108% of the Group 7 rate. In addition, Deputy Chief Asylum Support Adjudicator and Designated Immigration Judges in London and London Group 7 posts will continue to attract a London salary lead of £2,000 p.a. and a London Allowance of £2000 p.a.
10. £4,000 of this figure is designated as London Weighting.
