This paper informs users of changes to the NHS Data Model, NHS Data Dictionary and Commissioning Data Sets

Summary:

The NHS Data Dictionary definition of Person Marital Status Code has been amended to clarify the recording of Civil Partnerships.

This change is in line with the proposed changes to eGIF.

Healthcare organisations can use this clarified definition immediately; systems should be updated by 1st September 2006.

Reason for Change: The NHS Data Dictionary attribute Personal Marital Status Code has

been updated to enable recording of civil partnerships.

Background:

The Civil Partnership Act 2004 came into force on 5 December 2005, enabling same-sex couples to obtain legal recognition of their relationship. Couples who form a civil partnership will have a new legal status, that of 'civil partner'.

The Government Data Standards Catalogue (GDSC) entry for Person Marital Status includes a draft version with proposed e-Gif codes to record civil partnerships. Following recent definition queries surrounding Marital Status for the Mental Health Minimum Data Set, the current NHS Data Dictionary definition of Person Marital Status Code has been amended to enable recording of civil partnerships. It is recognised these codes are not identical to the e-Gif definition, however the codes remain compatible. The definitions will be updated further once an updated version of the Person Marital Status definition is released on the GDSC.

From October 2006 the Commissioning Data Sets will be submitted in XML format, and the national codes for recording Personal Marital Status Code for CDS EDIFACT messages have been retired.

Commissioning Data Set messages

Following the recommendation of the Data Protection Registrar, Marital Status should not be recorded by providers in the CDS except in respect of the psychiatric specialties in the Admitted Patient Care CDS. The data item remains in the data standards since it will be needed by the provider.

Mental Health Minimum Dataset messages

For the Mental Health Minimum Dataset (MHMDS), MARITAL STATUS must be recorded and kept up to date for all psychiatric patients as specified in version 2.5.1 of the MHMDS Data Manual:
