<b>DATA SET CHANGE NOTICE</b>	
This paper informs users of changes to the NHS Data Model or the NHS Data Dictionary that have been approved by the Information Standards Board	
<b>Summary:</b>  This Data Set Change Notice corrects and updates the OPCS-4 codes that are included in the national target 'Patients waiting longer than three months (13 weeks) for revascularisation'. These codes are listed as values in the data element "Admission Intended Procedure".  This change affects returns known by the service as the Monthly Monitoring Returns (MMR). <b>Reason for Change:</b>	The Percutaneous Transluminal Coronary Angioplasty OPCS-4 codes in the Code Value list in the NHS Data Model and Dictionary are incorrect.

#### Background:

This Data Set Change Notice corrects the OPCS-4 codes that are used to monitor against the national target 'Patients waiting longer than three months (13 weeks) for revascularisation'.

The information in the NHS Data Model and Dictionary has been updated as follows:

- Data Element - Admission Intended Procedure:
  - OPCS-4 Codes for Percutaneous Transluminal Coronary Angioplasty (PTCA) have been corrected as follows:

#### Corrections:

- K50. is incorrect and been replaced with K50.1;
- K51. is a diagnostic code and has been removed;

#### Updates:

- K75. is a new category of codes that were introduced in OPCS-4.3 and have been added to the list.

#### Notes:

- *K49 is still correct and*
- *0005 CHD - Coronary Heart Disease Coding Range has been removed as it is not a category on Unify.*

This is the grouping code for the specified Intended Patient Procedure for summarising in patient stocks. This is the code value list of OPCS codes used to:

- monitor specific targets (001 and 002), i.e. the "Patients waiting longer than three months (13 weeks) for revascularisation" target and
- monitor waiting times (003 and 004) for other cardiovascular related procedures that are not specifically included in the target above.

The grouping is based upon specified OPCS-4 codes as recorded by the CLINICAL CLASSIFICATION CODE of the CLINICAL CLASSIFICATION which is an OPERATIVE PROCEDURE for the PLANNED ACTIVITY of an ELECTIVE ADMISSION LIST ENTRY for a PATIENT being admitted electively. The groupings are based upon specified OPCS-4 codes as recorded by the CLINICAL CLASSIFICATION CODE of the CLINICAL CLASSIFICATION which is an OPERATIVE PROCEDURE for the PLANNED ACTIVITY of an ELECTIVE ADMISSION LIST ENTRY for a PATIENT being admitted electively.

When the OPCS-4 code of the OPERATIVE PROCEDURE is within the range of the specified ADMISSION INTENDED PROCEDURE for the sub group within the data set, the PATIENT should be included in the count providing all the other criteria of the count are also met.

An Intended Patient Procedure is a PLANNED ACTIVITY where PLANNED ACTIVITY TYPE is National Code 04 'Intended Patient Procedure'.
