<p>This paper informs users of the changes to the KP90 Central Return to meet the requirements of the Mental Health Act 2007.</p> <p>This was approved by the Information Standards Board for Health and Social Care (ISB HaSC) at its meeting on 24 September 2008.</p>		
<p><b>Summary:</b> This DSCN informs the NHS of changes to the KP90 form which is used to collect aggregate data about the number of uses made of the mental Health Act 1983 each year. It should be read by Mental Health Act administrators and information leads in trusts that provide mental health services in secondary care settings and which are registered to detain patients under the Mental Health Act 1983. It will also be relevant to all suppliers of information systems used in Mental Health services.</p> <p>The form needs updating in line with amendments in the Mental Health Act 2007, which comes into effect on 3 November 2008. It is required in order to enable The Department of Health to monitor uses of the Mental Health Act, as amended by the Mental Health Act 2007. The changes to the source data required for this aggregate have already been detailed in DSCN 06/2008.</p> <p>The main changes to the form are in the following areas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The replacement of 'Mental Category' with 'Mental Health Act 2007 Mental Category'</li><li>• The introduction of Supervised Community Treatments under section 17a</li></ul>

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### Introduction

KP90 is used to provide the Department of Health with information about the number of uses made of the Mental Health Act 1983 legislation (except for guardianship cases under sections 7 and 37) and other legislation. The purpose of the changes is to ensure that the KP90 form is still fit for purpose and can be used to record uses made of the Mental Health Act 1983, as amended by the Mental Health Act 2007.

The changes support information requirements in relation to monitoring of the Mental Health Act 2007 effective November 2008. The new form will collect aggregate data on Supervised Community Treatments and the associated powers of Recall and Revocation. The form no longer includes Mental Category, but uses the 'MHA 2007 Mental Category' instead.

The form is used by all providers of secondary mental health services registered to detain patients under the Mental Health Act 1983, but their systems will already have been updated to provide the source data for this aggregate return, in accordance with DSCN 06/2008.

### Background

The changes are necessary in order to enable the Department of Health and the Mental Health Act Commission to monitor uses of the Mental Health Act 1983 as amended by the Mental Health Act 2007, which comes into effect during the year 2008-2009.

### Details of Change

The main changes to different Parts of the Form are listed below. They are all consistent with DSCN 06/2008 which covers changes to the MHMDS source data for this aggregate return:

#### Part 1: Number of Admissions during the year

Mental Category: Mental Illness, Psychopathic Disorder, Mental Impairment, Severe Mental Impairment, Not Specified

is replaced by

MHA 2007: Mental Category: Mental disorder (Learning Disability NOT present or not primary reason for using Act), Mental disorder (Learning Disability primary reason for using Act)

This is in line with DSCN 06/2008 and with DSCN 21/2008 which provided clarification on MHA2007 Mental category.

For patients last detained prior to 3rd November 2008 one of the old mental categories may continue to be reported in the Mental Category data item on local Mental Health Act systems and in the

Information Standards Board for Health and Social Care MHMDS. However, for purposes of the KP90 collection it has been agreed with stakeholders that from 2008-09 **only** MHA 2007 Mental Categories will be included in the KP90 collection.

The guidance which accompanies the KP90 form explains how to complete the MHA 2007 Mental Category **for the purposes of the KP90 return only** for patients who were detained before the Mental Health Act 2007 came into effect in November 2008.

It is expected that the number of detained patients with an 'old' Mental Category recorded will reduce as Sections are renewed and records updated. For a small number of patients detained in hospital under Home Office restrictions under sections that are not regularly renewed, original mental categories assigned upon detention may persist until formal policy advice is provided to assign patients a MHA 2007 Mental Category.

## **Part 2: Changes in Legal Status under the Mental Health Act**

No change.

However, it should be noted that supervised discharge will not occur after 2 November 2008 and that the related values for Legal Status Changes to Supervised Discharge will not be collected after this date.

## **Part 3: Numbers of Patients resident in hospital and patients on SCT as at 31 March**

The Mental Category is changed as in Part 1. The scope of this section is expanded (and the heading amended) to include total number of patients on Supervised Community Treatment (and not resident in hospital) on 31 March and an extra line is added to collect this information.

## **Part 4: Uses of Supervised Community Treatment**

This is a new additional part to the form and requires aggregate data about the:

- Number of Supervised Community Treatments (SCT)
- Number of SCT Recalls to Hospitals
- Number of SCT Revocations
- Number of Discharges from SCT

As with the version 3.0.3 form, all these items can be calculated from existing data standards (as described in DSCN 06/2008).

## **Part 5: Additional Information**

## **Effects on Other Information Standards**

None. DSCN 06/2008 lists the KP90 as one of the information standards on which the changes to the MHMDS had an impact:

'KP90 - Admissions, Changes in Status and Detentions under the Mental Health Act: changes to Mental Category, in line with legislation, will be incorporated into a subsequent KP90 ISB HaSC Change submission.'
