At eight twenty (0820 hrs) on the thirty first of August nineteen ninety seven,  
I, Jean-Claude MULÈS,  
POLICE MAJOR  
an officer of the Judicial Police attached to the Criminal Investigation Department,  
in pursuance of the investigation on the same legal basis,  
attended the IML, 2, Place Mazas, Paris 12, for the forensic medical and post mortem examinations on the body of Henri PAUL, IML reference 2146 where, at the time shown above, the subject's body (1.67m, 76kg) was brought out.

After informing the competent forensic pathologist, Mme Professor Dominique LECOMTE, of the circumstances surrounding the death (a fatal road traffic accident), which was pronounced following attempted resuscitation by the emergency services, I was present during the examination.

It was agreed with the professor that she would pass her findings to me following the examination, which was done at 1000hrs, handing me the report and diagrams which I attach.

Urine  
Other routinely taken samples.

I also took possession of the victim's clothing, which had been cut during the course of resuscitation and which will be retained by Police in the event of the family requesting that they be restored.
