

## Future Jobs Fund Awards October 2009

### National bids (will create up to 600 jobs\*)

- **Action for Children** (third sector) will create up to 200 jobs in nine regions (London, South East, South West, East Midlands, West Midlands, North West, Yorkshire and the Humber and Wales).
- **Urban Futures** (private sector) will create up to 400 jobs in London and the East of England.
- **Community Empowerment** (third sector) will create jobs in six regions Yorkshire and the Humber, North West, East of England, South East, East Midlands, South West (\* precise numbers to be confirmed).

### London Bids (will create up to 695 jobs\*)

- **Youth League** – Barking and Dagenham (registered charity). Will create up to 54 jobs.
