The Bloody Sunday Inquiry was announced in a statement by the Prime Minister on 29 January 1998 to “inquire into the events of Sunday 30 January 1972 which led to loss of life in connection with the procession in Londonderry on that day, taking account of any new information relevant to the events of that day”.
2. The Inquiry’s Chairman is Lord Saville of Newdigate; the other two members of the Tribunal are the Honourable William Hoyt and the Honourable John Toohey.
3. The Inquiry began its oral hearings on 27 March 2000 at the Guildhall, Londonderry.
