Local Authority Unit (LAU)

Before consulting the LAU, regulators should take full advantage of existing LA networks. These include the use of the **link authority networks** and the various **regional pollution groups**.

The LAU should normally be contacted to raise **new** or **complex technical matters** and on queries regarding the technical guidance that they have drafted (PG and SG notes).

The LAU ask that for general enquiries, can you please use this point of contact instead of contacting members of the LAU directly (regardless of whether or not you have their direct contact details). Obviously you may contact a specific member of the LAU in reply to an email they have already sent as this would be a continuation of the initial enquiry. But all new queries should be sent to the LAU email address as it is constantly monitored by staff at the LAU for recording purposes. Any queries will be forwarded to the relevant person for their attention shortly upon receipt.
