**SUBJECT: ACTION A106 FROM CID INVESTIGATION TEAM INTO
THE MURDER OF ROSEMARY NELSON REQUESTING
INFORMATION ON LOYALIST BOMB MAKERS.**

The following intelligence is held by RUC Special Branch.

Intelligence indicates that loyalist paramilitaries deployed a number of UCBTs of a similar construction/use of components in the period from December 1996 to February 1998. These incidents are as follows:

- (1) 22.12.96 - UCBT which detonated on a vehicle in the driveway of [REDACTED] Ladbrook Drive, Belfast. IP- [REDACTED]
- (2) 28.12.96 - UCBT discovered underneath a car at Rose Court, Gobnascale, Londonderry. IP [REDACTED]
- (3) 16.1.97 - the suspected remains of an IED were discovered at the junction of Cooke Street/Ormeau Road, Belfast. [REDACTED]
- (4) 21.5.97 - UCBT which detonated on a car at Claremount Street, Belfast. IP- [REDACTED]
- (5) 25.10.97 - UCBT which detonated on a car at Drumhirk Drive, Kilcooley, Bangor. IP- GREER [REDACTED]
- (6) 21.2.98 - UCBT found underneath a car at Norglen Parade, Belfast. IP- [REDACTED]

In relation to incidents 1,2 and 3, Special Branch intelligence indicates that [REDACTED] was responsible for the construction of all 3 devices.

With regard to incident 4, Special Branch intelligence indicates that [REDACTED] constructed the UCBT used in the attack.

In relation to incident 5, intelligence suggests that [REDACTED] was involved in the construction of the device.

Further intelligence reporting in respect of [REDACTED] indicates that he has been involved in training [REDACTED] in bomb making.

In relation to incident 6, Special Branch intelligence indicates that [REDACTED] was responsible for the construction of the device.

The individuals highlighted above are identified as follows:
