

19. On the Saturday, when I was being taken into questioning for two hours, and then taken out for 15 minutes, and then back in again into the interview room, I asked to see Rosie again and I was panicking. When I saw Rosie, which was the second time I saw her, she reassured me and said *"You're doing alright. Keep your head up"*. When I saw Rosie at this time I didn't tell her what the officers were saying about her. I never said what they were saying about her whilst I was in Gough Barracks. I only told her afterwards when I got out. It wouldn't have done either of us any good for her to learn of it whilst I was still in there. As I left Gough on the Sunday, I didn't see Rosie any more whilst I was at the Barracks.
20. I was brought out around dinnertime and I was told that the people upstairs would decide whether they were charging me or not. I was then told that my case was being passed to the DPP and that I was going to be released. I was then brought back down to the cell to sign some papers. I asked the officers if they were bringing me home and they said no, they could not do this before 7.00 p.m., so I asked them to phone my parents instead.
21. When they letting me go the officers said to me *"Make sure that when you get out of Gough that you don't walk up and down or stand around outside the Barracks, because they know you're coming and you could be a target"*. I thought they were referring to the Loyalists. It was a well known fact that if you were lifted by the police then your name could be passed onto the Loyalists and Gough is up there in a Loyalist area. A cop said *"If you stand still outside of Gough and someone takes your photo then you're fucked"*.
22. I knew when I got out that I might be a target. On the first day you get out, your head is up your arse. I was all on edge. I had been sitting in a cell for four days, and so when you are walking along and someone looks at you, you think why is that c*** looking at me? Then after a while you realise it is all just because they played mind games with you.
