Re: Complaints made against officers from the Royal Ulster Constabulary.

I am writing to inform you that I have been appointed by the Chief Constable of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, following consultation with the Commissioner of the Metropolitan Police, to further investigate in respect of complaints made by Mrs Rosemary Nelson, Mr Colin Duffy and 'Lawyers Alliance for Justice in Ireland' in 1997. They are in regard to an allegation of conspiracy to pervert the course of justice and threats to Mrs Nelson, which you may have witnessed or in respect of which you have indicated that you may be able to provide pertinent information.

My appointment has been approved by the Independent Commission for Police Complaints for Northern Ireland (ICPC) who will be supervising my investigation of the complaint/s.

I am keen to pursue my investigation quickly and, in consultation with the ICPC, have provisionally made arrangements to use their premises at Chamber of Commerce House, 22 Great Victoria Street, Belfast (tel. 01232 244821) towards the end of September 1998.

It would greatly assist the investigation if I could see you in September at those premises to discuss the complaint in detail.

It would help matters if either you or your solicitor could confirm whether these arrangements would be suitable. I will write to you again when I have more detailed information on suitable dates. If you have any queries regarding this matter please do not hesitate to contact me through my office.
