

- Police explosives officer reports fatalities on top deck of bus possibly a maximum of 9.
- 1 HEMS doctor to go forward to bus with police explosives officer to confirm fatalities on board top deck of bus.
- 2 ambulances sent forward to prepare for removal of P2 patients.
- AOM S.Colhoun returns with P.Ward, PSU, on foot. P.Ward has been at the Russell Square incident and he requests all ambulances to Russell Square as they have 45 patients and no vehicles. 3 ambulances sent leaving one vehicle (Red Cross) at scene to be called forward as necessary.
- HEMS doctor returns from bus, unable to go on to confirm fatalities as explosives officer cannot confirm that the scene is safe.
- AOM S.Colhoun goes again on foot to try to locate AOM P.Gibson.
- EPM G.Long and Gold J.Pooley pass through area en route to Hendon.
- All HEMS doctors at scene instructed to go to Russell Square.
- Reports received of 5 patients in British Transport Police (BTP) HQ in Tavistock Place
- Radio communications are improving and we can hear other transmissions from other incidents.
- Russell Square incident Officers are requesting vehicles to scene.
- AOM S.Colhoun returns and reports that he has made contact with AOM J.Knott and R.Fox ,PSU, at rear of BMA building, who have 16 plus P3 patients and have 9 ambulances. They report that AOM P.Gibson requires no further assistance.
- AOM S.Colhoun sent back AOM J.Knott to send ambulances to Tavistock Square as holding area for Russell Square.
- P2 patients leave scene to Royal Free hospital.
- AOM T.Pidgeon reports that several GP'S on scene.
- Instructions to CAC to send ambulances to Russell Square.
- GP's are instructed to go forward to care for P3 patients left in building and to triage patients in BTP HQ with 1 LAS staff.
- EPM J.Edmonson arrives from Russell Square and informs that there is a suspect device at Sussex Gardens W2 which needs his attendance. He asks for an AOM to attend with him.
- AOM T.Pidgeon leaves with EPM Edmonson for Sussex Gardens
- Crew staff return from forward in building and dispatched to Russell Square on foot.
- Local café opened to LAS staff to use for toilets and refreshments and conference room made available to LAS in Tavistock Hotel.
