

## 7 Filters

In order to avoid complex routing instructions on the Census form, filter questions were included to progressively exclude certain groups from completing subsequent questions. This method was designed to reduce the burden on respondents by ensuring that they only answered relevant questions.

The purpose of these questions was to identify students and schoolchildren who were away from home at boarding school, college or university during term-time, and stop them from answering the remaining questions on the form. Only basic information on students who were not at their term-time address was collected (age, sex and marital status). These students were enumerated fully at their term-time address. See the *Glossary* in Chapter 5 for more information on students.

This filter aimed to ensure that people answered the appropriate question on religion or religion brought up in. Only those persons with a current religion were required to answer 8a. Similarly only those persons who did not have a current religion were expected to answer 8b.

This filter was intended to prevent any person aged 15 and under or 75 and over from answering the remaining questions on the Census form. The filter was included because qualification and economic activity questions are not applicable to people under the age of 16, and testing has shown that elderly and retired people object to answering what they see as irrelevant questions. In 1991, questions on economic activity were applicable to all people aged 16 and over, including those aged 75 and over.

This question acted as a filter to stop people who had never worked from answering the remaining questions on employment. In 1991, as well as people who had never worked, those who had last worked more than ten years ago were excluded from questions on employment.

In England and Wales and Northern Ireland, this filter aimed to stop people who were not working in the week before the Census from answering the remaining questions on the address of their place of work, method of transport and hours worked. Those who were working last week were directed to complete all the remaining questions.

## 7.8 No method of travel filter

## Scotland only

**10 What address do you travel to for your main job or course of study (including school)?**

In Scotland, the travel address and method of travel related to the person's place of work or place of study. As a result of this, the order of the questions and the routing through them was different from the rest of the UK. The 'not currently working filter' was not applied. The additional 'no method of travel' filter directed people who were not currently working or studying or who work or study at or from home past the method of travel question.

## 8 Output tables

### Introduction

8.1 This section provides a brief description of the sets of tables produced from the 2001 Census. The tables themselves are listed on page 120 of this Report.

8.2 Aggregated results from the 2001 Census are provided in statistical tables. The tables are grouped within broad categories as described below. For ease of reference, each table is given an identifier (such as CAS031) as well as a title indicating the topics covered by the table. In general, tables with the same identifier will have an identical layout, though there are some exceptions to this described below.

8.3 Whilst great effort has been made to make the tables consistent for all parts of the UK, there are many tables which are produced for one part of the UK but not for others. This can reflect a difference in data collected; in the perceived needs of users; or the policies adopted by the Census organisations. The list of tables on page 120 provides information on the parts of the UK for which each table is produced. A file available on the ONS website, or from Census Customer Services allows the identification of tables relating to a particular topic for any part of the UK, or for the UK as a whole. ### Key Statistics

8.4 Key Statistic Tables, identified by 'KS' preceding the table number, provide a summary of Census results for a particular topic, such as Tenure, and allow comparison of results for different areas within a single table. These tables are produced for all areas for which results are produced as standard, from Output Areas through the range of administrative and other geographies described in *Chapter 2*. Some Key Statistics tables have slightly different specifications in different parts of the UK, and these differences are noted in the list of tables on page 120.

### Standard Tables

8.5 Standard Tables provide detailed results for selected areas: namely wards and higher administrative areas and health administration areas (all parts of the UK) and postcode sectors (Scotland only). There are two types of Standard Table.

#### 'S' Tables

8.6 These tables, identified by an 'S' preceding the table number, provide a cross-tabulation of two or more Census variables, such as age and sex. Tables are numbered S001 – S068 (available for all parts of GB, with the majority also available in Northern Ireland); S101 – S161 (England and Wales only); S201 – S248 (Scotland only) and S301 – S411A (Northern Ireland only). (The description 'Standard Table' is sometimes used to refer to these 'S' tables only.)

#### Theme Tables

8.7 These tables, identified by a 'T' preceding the table number, bring together a range of results on a particular population, such as dependent children. Unlike the 'S' tables, the numbering of the Theme Tables does not indicate the part of the UK for which the table is produced.

### Census Area Statistics

8.8 Census Area Statistics provide the most detailed results possible for smaller areas. They are generally produced for the same areas as the Key Statistics. There are three types of Census Area Statistics table. (The description 'CAS table' is often used to describe the full set of Census Area Statistics including CAS Theme Tables and Univariate Tables.)

#### CAS Tables

8.9 These tables, identified by 'CAS' preceding the table number, provide a cross-tabulation of two or more Census variables, such as age and sex. Tables are numbered CAS001 – CAS068 (available for all parts of GB, with the majority also available in Northern Ireland); CAS101 – CAS147 (England and Wales only); CAS203 – CAS248 (Scotland only) and CAS301 – CAS385 (Northern Ireland only). CAS tables are usually 'collapsed' versions of the corresponding 'S' table – thus S001 will provide more detailed results on the same topics contained in CAS001.

### CAS Theme Tables

8.10 These tables, identified by 'CAST' preceding the table number, bring together a range of results on a particular population, such as dependent children. Unlike the 'CAS' tables, the numbering of the Theme Tables does not indicate the part of the UK for which the table is produced. CAST tables are not available in Northern Ireland.

### Univariate Tables

8.11 Univariate Tables, identified by 'UV' preceding the table number, are designed to provide as much detail about a single topic, such as Country of Birth. Unlike the 'CAS' tables, the numbering of the Univariate Tables does not indicate the part of the UK for which the table is produced

### Origin-Destination Statistics

8.12 The Origin-Destination matrices provide information on flows of migrants or people travelling to work or, in Scotland, study from one specific geographical area to another. These flows can relate to migration ('MG' tables), travel to work ('W' tables), or travel to place of work or study ('TV' tables). In addition to overall counts of the flows between areas, the tables provide disaggregations by various topics, such as age and ethnicity. Each table can be thought of as a cell within a matrix of geographical areas as illustrated below for local authorities:

### Other tables

#### Registrar General's 2001 Census report to the Scottish Parliament

8.13 This report containing 24 tables and an Appendix table provides a mix of analyses of 2001 Census results and comparisons of 2001 with 1991. Most of the tables are for Scotland only but some give figures for Scottish council areas. The Appendix to the report gives figures for Scottish Parliamentary Constituencies.

#### Profiles

8.14 The sets of tables described above are supplemented by a small number of profiles, designed to bring together key results for a certain type of area.

#### Parish profiles (England and Wales only)

Parish profiles are designed to provide condensed summary results on a particular topic and are available for small parishes (with at least 50 people and 20 households) for which the Key Statistics are not produced. There are four parish profiles and they are identified by 'PP' preceding the table number.

#### Parliamentary constituency profile

The Parliamentary Constituency profile (PC01) is produced for all UK Parliamentary constituencies and is designed to provide easily comparable headline statistics for areas across the UK.

#### Postcode sector profile (England and Wales only)

The postcode sector profiles provide summary results of particular interest to users of postcode information. There are three postcode sector profiles, identified by 'PSP' preceding the table number.

#### Welsh language profile (Wales only)

The Welsh Language Profile WLP01 is produced for all community council areas in Wales and is designed to provide summary results of particular interest to users of Census information on skills in Welsh.

#### Scottish profiles

Five profiles produced for Scotland relate to Population, Households, Health, Education and Employment. These appear on the SCROL website and, tables CP1 to CP5, in the Reference Volume

**Northern Ireland profiles**

Seven profiles produced for Northern Ireland on the following topics: Demographics, Households, Cultural, Health and Care, Education, Economic Activity and Employment. These profiles are available exclusively through the Northern Ireland Census Access website ([www.nicensus2001.gov.uk](http://www.nicensus2001.gov.uk)).

Commissioned tables produced by NISRA and Scotland are described at [www.nisra.gov.uk/Census/Census2001Output/commissioned\\_output.html](http://www.nisra.gov.uk/Census/Census2001Output/commissioned_output.html) and [www.gro-scotland.gov.uk/grosweb/grosweb.nsf/pages/scotcen22](http://www.gro-scotland.gov.uk/grosweb/grosweb.nsf/pages/scotcen22) respectively.

**Armed Forces Tables (England and Wales only)**

8.15 Tables AF01 – AF04 provide information on members of the Armed Forces. These tables are produced for local authorities and higher administrative areas only.

**Head counts (England and Wales only)**

8.16 A simple count of all people, males, females and the number of households is provided under the identifier HC01 for all parishes in England and communities in Wales. Similar information is also provided for unit postcodes.

**First releases (England and Wales only)**

8.17 Results from the 2001 Census in England and Wales were first released in September 2002 in a set of simple tables of age by sex identified as P1 – P7 (and WP1 – WP4 in tables for Wales only). As small changes were made to the Census output database between the first release and the publication of the main results users are advised to use table S001 in preference to these tables.

**Commissioned tables**

8.18 Each of the Census organisations produces commissioned tables to meet requirements not met by the sets of tables described above. These tables, once produced, are given a unique identifier and are made freely available to other users.

Most commissioned tables produced for England and Wales will be identified by a 'C' preceding the table number while those in Northern Ireland are preceded by 'EXT'. Tables produced as part of the ONS' multi-source topic report project are identified by 'M' preceding the table number. Tables produced by the UK Census organisations to meet Eurostat requirements have been identified by 'ES' preceding the table number. Tables for Scotland are numbered and held according to the Customer Services order number.
