1. Name of the deceased: Emad El-Din Mohamed Abdel Moneim Al Fayed
2. Injury or disease causing death :
 - 1a. Multiple injuries (including severe impact injury to the chest and transaction of the aorta)
3. Time, place and circumstances at or in which injury was sustained ('narrative conclusion'):

Dodi Al Fayed died in the Alma Underpass in Paris at around 12.22am on 31 August 1997, as the result of a motor crash. The crash was caused or contributed to by:
